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Wednesday Leaving Shropshire around midday we travel to Newcastle, arriving in time to clear customs and board our ship in time for a late evening departure and cruising through the night.

Thursday Today we shall be at sea, with a chance to enjoy all the ship's many facilities until arrival at Oslo early Friday morning.

Friday Docking in Oslo there will be a chance to join in with one of the shore excursions on offer. It is said that Oslo has more open space close to the city centre than any other European Capitol. Down by the harbour there is a teeming area of activity. Aker Brygge offers open air and indoor restaurants of many nationalities, with theatres and scores of shops of all kinds. We depart from Oslo Late evening and sail through the night along the Oslofjord and out into the Skagerrak. Once again we can avail ourselves of the ships numerous amenities.

Saturday Once we arrive in Gothenburg maybe you would like a city tour or one of the other excursion possibilities all bookable on board. Gothenburg is compact and interesting, small enough to walk round, with plenty of open air bars and cafes in which to unwind. Founded in 1621 by King Gustav the Great, who ushered in the Golden Age of Sweden, Gothenburg was

designed and built by Dutch planners, which accounts for the city's network of canals. Leaving Gothenburg our cruise continues through the Kattegat and on through the night.

Sunday This morning finds us in our third Scandinavian country, wonderful Copenhagen where once again we can join the excursions to fully appreciate this interesting city. Visitors to Copenhagen are greeted by the statue of the Little Mermaid, a reminder that this was the home of her creator, and one of the world's greatest storytellers, Hans Christian Andersen. Located at the mouth of the Baltic Sea, Copenhagen has a long history as the 'Royal' city of Denmark. At the centre, the glorious Christiansborg Palace -was re-built several times following devastating fires, once the residence of the Danish Royal family it is now the site of the Danish Parliament. The end of the day sees us cruising on through the night.

Monday Today will find us at sea, why not make the most of the ship's extensive entertainment programme or just relax and chill out in one of the on board bars and lounges.

Tuesday We will arrive once again in Newcastle where our coach will be waiting to return us to Shropshire, arriving home later in the day.
