ITINERARY

Monday

We travel north, stopping at Gretna then circling Glasgow we cross over the Clyde and travel through the Campsie Fells to our Hotel in Drymen.

Tuesday

Today our journey takes us along the shores of Loch Lomond to Tyndrum, we travel over Rannoch Moor and down Glen Coe to Fort William. The last part of our day sees us drive along Glen Shiel and across to the Isle of Skye and our Hotel in Broadford.

Wednesday

This morning we will make the short drive to Portree with its picturesque harbour. We travel to Uig where we catch our second ferry today across to North Uist before checking into the Dark Island Hotel at Benbecula.

Thursday

Today we head north and the ferry crossing to the largest of the Hebridean Islands, the Isle of Harris. It has a rugged landscape of moorland, deep-sea lochs and mountains. Against this backdrop is a proud history going right

back to prehistoric times. We travel to the north end of Lewis and the capital, Stornoway, where we stay for the next 2 nights at the Caberfeidh Hotel.

Friday

We can enjoy a full day tour of Lewis and Harris, with an island guide, including the impressive standing stones of Callanish (Scotland's Stonehenge, but older). We will pass ancient thatched "blackhouses", the Broth at Carloway and a visit to a Tweed Mill.

Saturday

Today we depart the Hebrides on the crossing to Ullapool and head towards Inverness, the "Capital of the Highlands". Our journey continues south, through picturesque Spey Valley and into Perthshire for our last nights stay in Scotland at Highlander Hotel, Newtonmore.

Sunday

Leaving our Hotel we travel south past Stirling to the border with England, then on using the motorway system to arrive home in Shropshire early evening.
